

Flight Level Aviation Academy

Course Introduction:

Introduction of aviation
This course aims at introducing pilots-to-be to the prerequisites of becoming professional pilots. It comprises these components: Ground Theory Classes, Career Orientation and Flight Simulation

First Solo
This course serves as an introductory theory-course for pilots, which is delivered by licensed Australia flight instructors. Upon the completion of the theory-course, students will be departing to Australia and receive a one-month flight training. Students will be required to perform take offs and landings in the absence of flight instructors at the final stages of the training.

BAK
This course prepares students for the Recreational Pilot License (RPL) test. Theory courses and flight simulations will be offered, followed by a one-month flight training at Australia. Recreational Pilot License (RPL) will be issued after the completion of trainings and passing the test.

Private Pilot Licence
This course prepares students for the Private Pilot License test. Theory courses, flight simulations and interview trainings for pilots will be offered, followed by one month of flight trainings at Australia. Private Pilot License will be issued upon the completion of trainings and passing the test.

Commercial Pilot License (CPL) (Private Pilot License course included)
CPL is a professional piloting course. Students will be first provided with 3 months of training at Hong Kong, then receive 15 months of flight training at Australia. Students will gain pilot qualification and be able to work as a pilot upon completion of the course and passing the test. ANAC will also issue a diploma.
